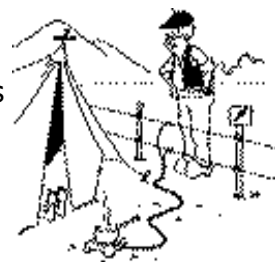
There is a charge of \$2.00 per person for ice cream.
